

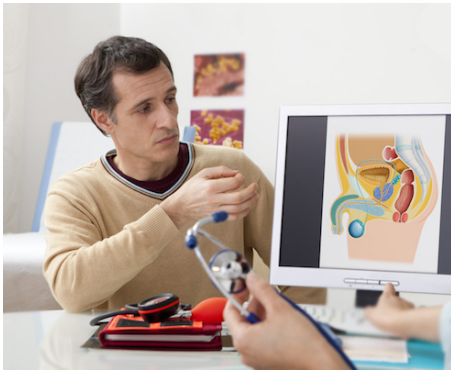
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Vasectomy Reversal NY



Your postoperative success following any surgical procedure is dependent in no small part on the skill and experience of the surgeon. Vasectomy reversal surgery is no different. Dr Harry Fisch is an internationally renowned, board certified urologist who not only has treated many individuals who have successfully undergone vasectomy reversal surgery; he in fact pioneered the microsurgical techniques that have dramatically increased the success rate of vasectomy reversal.

So how does vasectomy reversal work? The surgery, using microsurgical techniques, reconnects the ducts that carry sperm from the testicles into the semen, thus allowing men the opportunity to try to get their partner pregnant. Provided the surgery is successful, the average time from reversal surgery to conception is 12 months.

The initial consultation costs just \$175.

At \$12,500, the cost of microsurgical vasectomy reversal is more economical than in-vitro fertilization (IVF) that can range from \$8,000 to \$15,000. On top of that, The Society for Assisted Reproductive Technology, and its parent organization, the American Society for Reproductive Medicine, have reported that the national birth rate for IVF is only 28.9% per cycle. IVF is therefore an option to consider if vasectomy reversal is unsuccessful, rather than an alternative to surgery.

Please note that Dr Fisch administers sedation with every procedure to maximize comfort and decrease anxiety. The fees listed above include: surgeon, anesthesia, and operating room costs.
